

About Your Weekly Reading Log

Students are to read at least 15 minutes each school day AND complete a reading log entry DURING the reading session.

At the beginning of each week, fill in your **name** and **number**, the **due date** of the log, and **how many entries** are required that week. Then, as you read, **fill in each box as follows:**

The DATE box—Include the day and date. Ex. — Mon., 9/12.

The TITLE box—Write the title of the book, magazine, or other selection. Underline or use quotation marks appropriately. *If you read more than one selection, give every title.

The MINUTES box—Tell *how many minutes* you read.
(Remember, you **MUST** read at least 15 minutes each day.)

The WORD box—Choose one word that is new or interesting **WHILE YOU ARE READING** and write it neatly in the designated box. Then, after reading write a brief definition for how it was used in the text. Use a dictionary if you don't know the word's meaning.

The INITIAL box—Alert an adult* **BEFORE** you read that you are going to read for your log. Once you have read and filled out the log entry completely, show the adult your completed log. Have them initial the designated box to confirm that you have read for the time written on your log.

*A qualifying adult can be a day care worker, a babysitter, or any other supervising adult (not just a parent).

Reading logs will be collected the last day of the week.
