Study Hall is intended to meet the needs of students who seek a quiet environment in which to individually complete assignments. Students are expected to arrive in class with work to complete, a book to read, or some other appropriate individual activity to do. Study Hall is **not** an appropriate place for students to complete work of a “group” or “partner” nature.

Grade Breakdown:

- Daily Log (70%)
- Classroom behavior (30%)

Daily Log:

Before you leave each day, you will record the date and specific activity you worked on. You will leave your log sheet on your desk when you leave at the end of the period. Each day your log sheet will be reviewed.

If your descriptions of your work in Study Hall are missing, inaccurate or “vague,” it will be noted and you will need to stay after the bell rings the following day to review the missing information with your teacher. You will also be deducted points.

On days that you are absent, mark “absent” on the log.

Classroom Behavior:

- Be on time and ready to work when the bell rings
- Raise your hand if you need to get out of your seat for any reason
- Work quietly and do not talk with your neighbors
- Use your time before school, during break, at lunch, and after school to run errands (such as getting help from other teachers, getting sports equipment ready, etc)
- No food or drink except water
